

From the Desk of the Executive Director

Dear Church Family,

February is famous for Valentine's Day, a happy day for some and a stressful day for others. We see roses in the stores, delivery trucks with flowers and treats, and restaurant reservations book early. What is the root of love? The greatest commandment is to "Love the Lord



with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength" Mark 12:30 (NIV). The second greatest commandment from God is to "Love your neighbors as yourself" Mark 12:31 (NIV).

With the love of God ruling your heart, loving your neighbors becomes a little easier. Even in difficult times, asking God to go before you into a situation or conversation is a helpful way to show God's love to others. When was the last time you were fully engaged in a conversation, not thinking about what you will say next but actively listening to another speak? When you say "how are you," do you mean it, or is it a type of greeting. In these strange days of isolation and fear, how can we love our neighbors well? Active listening and full engagement in conversation are two ways to care for our neighbors. Thinking about loving our neighbors on a grander scale might mean volunteering in a ministry that is near and dear to your heart or volunteering in a place you would like to learn more about. VPC is always looking for ways to reach and touch our community. Consider volunteering in the new year as a way to serve and love your neighbors.

Another way to *love your neighbor is to pray for them*. I've said before, sometimes the greatest influence you can have on another is to pray for them. The intercessory prayer team is a confidential team that wants to pray for you. A great resource that I would recommend is the book "Too Busy Not To Pray". It helps us to understand we should never be too busy not to commune with God through prayer. Prayer is a two way street. When you set apart your prayer time, remember to listen. Take time to clear your mind and listen.


Scholarships are granted based on service to:

MICROSOFT BASICS	(4 Weeks – Tuesdays 3-5:00 рм, Feb. 15-Mar. 8) Room 9

February Monthly Mission Partner: Agape Flight

Imagine a world where missionaries never lack the resources to share the unconditional love of Christ. Agape Flights mission is to provide excellent aviation service delivering cargo, mail and humanitarian aid to missionary partners serving Christ, carrying hope to the nations of the Caribbean.



Nearly 20 million people live in the areas regularly reached by Agape's flights to Haiti, the Dominican Republic and the Bahamas. More than 350 missionary families rely on Agape Flights to transport the mail and supplies they need while living and working on the mission field in Haiti, the Dominican Republic, and the Bahamas. but all 14 soldiers were saved as well as all of Quamos men and then some. Many pages are devoted to Major Quamo in Dave Stockwell's book Route 9 Problem The Battle For Lang Vei. Quamo was considered handsome, brilliant, charismatic, and cool under pressure and in Vietnam was known as the Lawrence of Arabia of Vietnam. Not just the ladies, but all are invited to attend the final PW Gathering of the season on Tues., April 19 at 12:30 pm. Our Honorary Life Member (Woman of The Year) will be awarded at this PW Gathering. There will be a collection of the Least Coin which is one of our mission givings.

At this time, a heartfelt thanks goes out to pastor Carolyn Wilson for her great support as our staff liaison.
